**DESCRIPTION:** Resolution Certifying Costs of Prosecuting Crimes Alleged to Have Been Committed by Persons in the Custody of the Colorado Department of Corrections.

**SUMMARY:** Colorado Revised Statute § 16-18-101(3) provides that the Colorado Department of Corrections (CDOC) shall reimburse the counties in a judicial district for the costs of prosecuting any crime alleged to have been committed by a person in the CDOC when such costs are certified to the CDOC by the counties within a judicial district. The attached resolution provides certification of costs incurred by the District Attorney's Office while prosecuting alleged crimes in the Limon Correctional Facility. Approval and submission of this executed resolution will allow the County to obtain reimbursement for these costs on behalf of the District Attorney.
