**DESCRIPTION:** Resolution for Temporary Road Closures Associated with the Pine Drive and Pine Lane Improvements Project, Douglas County Project Numbers CI 2020-019 and CI 2020-020.

**SUMMARY:** Douglas County Public Works Engineering and the Contractor selected for the Pine Drive and Pine Lane Improvements Project has identified three temporary road closures that are necessary for construction of the project. These closures will take place during the projects contractual time period, between July 29, 2026 and July 30, 2027.

The first closure is needed for installation of a portion of a new 96-inch culvert that passes under the Pine Drive and Ponderosa Drive intersection. The closure will be of Pine Drive approximately 1000 feet south of the intersection with Ponderosa Drive and will be for a maximum of 6 days.

The second closure is needed for installation of required storm sewer infrastructure improvements, new roadway construction and ancillary roadway improvements on Ponderosa Drive. The closure will be of Ponderosa Drive, west of Pine Drive, approximately 1000 feet and will be for a maximum of 60 days.

The third closure is needed for installation of required storm sewer infrastructure improvements, new roadway construction and ancillary roadway improvements on Pine Lane. The closure begins near the intersection of Pine Lane and Crown Crest Boulevard and extends east up to the intersection with Pine Drive. The closure will be for a maximum of 75 days.

Access to all residents, churches, and businesses will remain open throughout the duration of all road closure. All temporary road closures provide a safer condition for the construction crews and the traveling public. These road closures were identified as necessary during project design and discussed at a staff level and with the County's engineering consultant who prepared the

construction phasing plans. Pine Lane and Ponderosa Drive will not be closed at the same time. Public information efforts for notification of this work and closures will be communicated with nearby residents, churches and businesses. Detailed detour instructions will be communicated through the proper channels to the residents, churches, businesses and traveling public ahead of the closures.

The method for handling traffic (MHT) will be reviewed and approved by Douglas County Engineering staff prior to implementation of these road closures.
