LOCAL LIQUOR LICENSING AUTHORITY HEARING:

I. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The District Court of Douglas County issued judgments on November 3, 2023, and November 8, 2023, which order the Douglas County Sheriff's Office to remove the licensee and current operator of the establishment, MFM, LLC (d.b.a. The Stagecoach), from the property.

Colorado Revised Statutes (C.R.S.) § 44-3-301(3)(b) provides that "at all times a licensee shall possess and maintain possession of the premises or optional premises for which the license is issued by ownership, lease, rental, or other arrangement for possession of the premises."

As a result, this item is being presented to the Liquor Licensing Authority (Authority) to assess the potential violation and penalty.

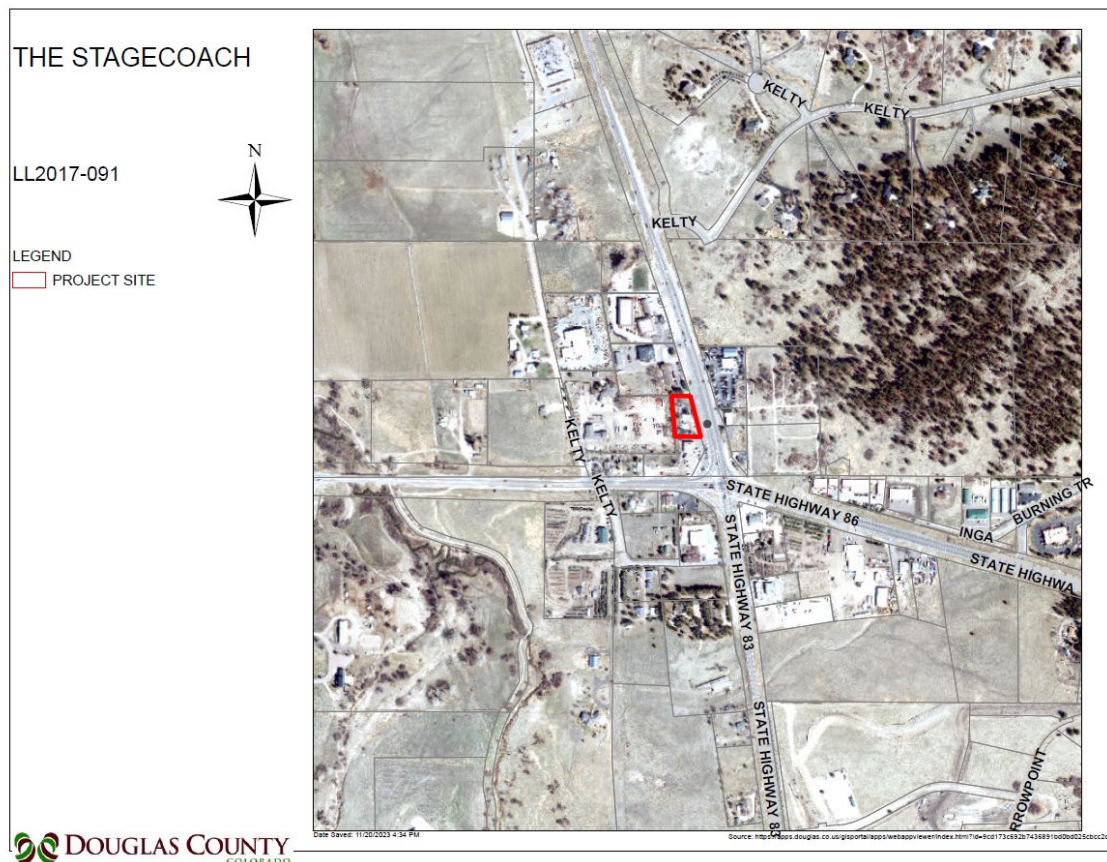
II. BACKGROUND

On September 29, 2023, staff was notified that The Stagecoach owner and liquor license holder, Michelle Munsey, had passed away. The State's Liquor Enforcement Division (LED) visited the establishment during the week of October 3, 2023 and was informed that Derrick Vasquez was a common law spouse to the owner that passed. Additional information was provided indicating the current MFM, LLC liquor license would be transferred to him.

The owner of the building (RDB Properties, LLC) received a judgement for possession of the premises from the District Court of Douglas County on November 3, 2023. A writ of restitution was also issued by the District Court on November 8, 2023, ordering the Sheriff's Office to remove MFM, LLC from the property. As a result of this action, the licensee has been ordered to vacate the premises for which the current liquor license is issued. Due to ongoing court actions, staff continues to coordinate with the County Attorney's Office and Douglas County Sheriff's Office on these orders.

III. LOCATION

The site is located at 2077 N State Highway 83, in Franktown, at the northwest corner of the intersection of E State Highway 86 and N State Highway 83.



IV. AUTHORITY

Authority to act on this violation is provided under C.R.S. § 44-3-601(1)(a).

Due to the nature of the potential violation, staff is prepared to present preliminary information to the Authority at a public hearing on December 4, 2023. The Authority may issue a temporary 15-day suspension of the liquor license at the December 4th hearing if it finds reasonable grounds to believe the licensee has committed a deliberate and willful violation of any applicable law or regulation, or that the public health, safety or welfare imperatively requires emergency action. A temporary suspension would cease any authority for MFM, LLC to sell alcohol, while also providing additional time for the license holder to prepare any evidence regarding the potential violation for presentation at the December 18, 2023, scheduled hearing.

The Authority may issue a permanent transfer or revocation of the license at the hearing on December 18, 2023, after the licensee is afforded an opportunity to present evidence, if the Authority finds good cause, based on substantial evidence, to conclude that the licensee has lost possession of the premises.


V. PUBLIC NOTICE

A notice letter was mailed to the license holder on Tuesday, November 21, 2023, providing information on the time, date, and location of the scheduled hearings, as well as information on the potential actions the Authority may take.

VI. CONCLUSION

The final determination and assessment of penalties for liquor license violations is at the discretion of the Authority.

JUDGMENT FOR POSSESSION	

This matter comes before the Court on a complaint for Forcible Entry and Detainer. The finds the following:

1. The court finds that Venue is property in this Court and the Court has jurisdiction over the parties and subject matter of this action.
2. Plaintiff and applicant intervenor appeared for a hearing on the matters of possession and applicant intervenor Derek Vasquez's Motion and Complaint to Intervene on October 26, 2023.
3. Plaintiff was represented by counsel of record, Denise M. Haack with Parker Law Group, and Applicant Intervenor Derek Vasquez appeared with counsel Frederick Ginsberg.
4. The court heard argument on Derek Vasquez's Complaint and Motion to Intervene, which was denied.
5. The court took testimony from authorized agent for Plaintiff regarding Defendant's breach of lease.
6. The Court finds that Defendant breached its lease agreement and finds that Plaintiff is entitled to possession of the premises.
7. The Court stayed its order until October 31, 2023 to allow applicant intervenor to locate an operating agreement for defendant with a succession clause.
8. No such operating agreement has been submitted.
9. The court's stay has expired.


Therefore, the Court orders possession in favor of the Plaintiff, RDB Properties, LLC, for the property located at 2077 N. State Highway 83, Franktown, Colorado, 80116.


