SUMMARY

This is an update for the Parks Operations Team for August 2024.

Highlands Ranch 4th of July Parade

Parks staff along with the Commissioners had the opportunity to participate in the Highlands Ranch 4th of July parade. Staff members towed a tractor on a trailer with banners and handed out foam sports balls, waters and candy to the many citizens celebrating the holiday.





Native Mowing

With over 100 properties maintained throughout the County, Parks staff has a lot of ground to cover. Several hundred acres of native grass is maintained throughout these properties. Typically, these areas are mowed 3-4 times during the season depending on rainfall. Each of which can take up to three weeks to accomplish. Parks staff is currently on round two of mowing native areas this year.
