**DESCRIPTION:** First Amendment of Contract and Purchase Order to Security Central, Inc. for 2025 Scheduled Facility Alarm Monitoring Services to Douglas County Locations per Award of IFB #048-21, in the Amount of \$35,000.00.

**SUMMARY:** In December 2021, an Invitation for Bid process was completed, and Security Central Inc. was awarded IFB #048-21 as the successful bidder. Based on the Term, the Parties agreed to, and the County paid to the Contractor \$33,528.99 for fiscal year 2023 \$33,528.99 for fiscal year 2024, and \$35,000.00 for fiscal year 2025.

Now, both Parties have agreed to amend the Contract for a second time by increasing the Maximum Contract Expenditure. The Second Amendment is for Thirty-Five Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents (\$35,000.00) for the fiscal year 2026.

With the addition of this Second Amendment to the Contract of Thirty-Five Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents (\$35,000.00), the total allocation for services is One Hundred Seventy Thousand Five Hundred Eighty-Six Dollars and Ninety-Seven Cents (\$170,586.97) for services outlined in the contract.

Funding is available in the Douglas County Facilities, Fleet & Emergency Support Services (FFESS) budget.
