**DESCRIPTION:** Douglas County Sheriff's Office is Requesting Board of County Commissioners Approval for \$115,010.00 to Fund the Ongoing Purchase and Replacement of Deputy Sheriff Uniforms. This Funding will Ensure that Deputies Maintain a Professional and Consistent Appearance in Accordance with Department Standards.

**SUMMARY:** This purchase order (PO) is intended for the ongoing replacement of commissioned deputy uniforms, including shirts and pants. With the implementation of External Vest Carriers (EVCs) and the adoption of Class A, B, and C uniforms, this request supports the department's continued efforts to enhance officer safety, functionality, and professionalism. Uniforms require regular replacement due to wear and fading from daily use.

The total amount for this purchase is **\$115,010.00**, ensuring deputies are properly equipped for duty and maintain a consistent, professional appearance. Funding was approved and available in the 2025 Adopted Budget.

**RECOMMENDED ACTION:** Request the Board approve the purchase request above totaling \$115,010.00 to Skaggs, Public Safety Uniforms & Equipment.
