DESCRIPTION: First Amendment to Contract to Exchange Real Property Between Douglas

County, SR Acquisitions LLC, SR Waterton LLC, and SR Conservation LLC

SUMMARY: SR Acquisitions LLC, SR Waterton LLC, and SR Conservation LLC

collectively propose an amendment to the existing real estate exchange between Douglas County and SR Acquisitions LLC. The amendment will

provide Douglas County with an additional 34.2 acres of land in a

configuration that is intended to facilitate development of a sports complex adjacent to Waterton Road. In exchange for this additional land, SR Waterton LLC will receive and additional 23.8 acres along Moore Road and in-kind recreational use benefits for residents of Sterling Ranch. The amendment retains the obligation for SR Waterton and its affiliated parties to conserve an elk migration corridor west and north of Louviers as open space under either a conservation easement or open space zone designation. The amendment

modifies the northwestern boundary of the open space parcel to accommodate a

portion of the proposed sports complex.
