DESCRIPTION: 2026 Intergovernmental Agreement for Law Enforcement and Animal Control Services Between the City of Castle Pines and the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County on Behalf of the Douglas County Sheriff's Office in the Amount of \$1,813,013.00.

SUMMARY: This 2026 Intergovernmental Agreement outlines the provisions pertaining to the continuation of the law enforcement and animal control services provided to the City of Castle Pines by the Douglas County Sheriff's Office for the period of January 1, 2026 through December 31, 2026.

The City of Castle Pines will pay a total of \$1,813,013 which is comprised of \$1,785,565 for law enforcement services and \$27,448 for animal control services. The law enforcement portion will be paid to the Douglas County Law Enforcement Authority Fund and is equal to a 4.5 mill levy on the 2025 final assessed valuation of \$402,891,918 for the City. The animal control portion offsets the costs incurred in the General Fund for animal control services and is based on a proportional share of the total animal control calls for service in unincorporated Douglas County, the City of Castle Pines and the Town of Larkspur in 2025.
