Since September, our department has secured an additional \$538,751 in grant funding, further strengthening our ability to support essential public health programs. These funds supplement the grants previously awarded earlier in the year and continue to reinforce our department's financial stability.

We continue to navigate ongoing funding adjustments, particularly within federal programs, but our strategic approach to resource management has allowed us to remain flexible. Even with fluctuations in certain grants, we have been able to sustain and fund critical areas of need through targeted use of available grant dollars.
