

## Community Health Update - March 2025

## **Activities:**

- Clinical Services: DCHD is in the process of contracting with the Public Health Institute at Denver Health and ColoVAX to provide ongoing immunization services in the County. Each entity will hold up to 12 vaccine events annually to support uninsured and underinsured individuals and families in the community. The Department is also looking to partner with Julissa Soto Health Equity Consulting to continue working to address vaccine access in the Hispanic community.
- Healthy Families Partnership: The Healthy
   Families Partnership has continued to have
   great success in supporting newly birthing
   families in Douglas County. With the formal
   launch of the program at all four hospitals in the



County, 1,500 Healthy Families Partnership bags that includes sleep sacks and safe sleep education have been distributed to families. The Partnership is currently working on adding educational information around car seat safety and developmental milestones in the first 18 months of life.

The Partnership held its first meeting of 2025 on February 27<sup>th</sup> and heard a presentation on men's mental health from defyThemAll, a social marketing firm that the County partnered with around men's mental health in 2024. The Partnership is now looking at how it can integrate resources on mental well-being for both mothers and fathers in educational materials and on the Healthy Families Partnership webpage.

 Nurse Support Program: Since late 2022, DCHD has partnered with the Department of Human Services and their child welfare team to offer home visits from a registered nurse, as part of the Nurse Support Program. This program supports the Child Maltreatment Prevention Plan for the County through prevention, education, support, and resources.

In 2024, 88 cases that were screened out by case workers were referred to the Nurse Support Program and 20 cases that were engaged in 2023 continued their engagement with the nurse in 2024. A variety of resources and education were provided to families for conditions including but not limited to: complex medical issues, mental health and substance misuse, developmentally appropriate growth and behavior, disease management, breastfeeding support, bed bug eradication, mold remediation, and tickborne illnesses.

WIC: The partnership with Northeast Colorado Health Department (NCHD) has
continued to be a positive one. DCHD was able to bring on a registered dietician at the
beginning of January that provides remote nutrition support for pregnant women and
families identified as high risk. DCHD and NCHD have met with state staff to discuss the
progress of the partnership, challenges, and successes. This partnership is seen as a
model for other WIC agencies across the state and both agencies have been happy to
share best practices with this type of partnership model.

The annual Food Dollars Report from CDPHE showed that WIC families redeemed \$1,440,269.48 during the 2024 calendar year at one of 24 participating retail stores in the County.

Community Partner Highlights: DCHD was approached by the 23<sup>rd</sup> Judicial District to provide HIV testing to out of custody defendants who are bound over for trial for any sexual offense as per CRS 18-3-415. As the Department previously received funding from CDPHE for STI testing and has staff trained as certified phlebotomy technicians, this is a wonderful opportunity to expand partnership and support for the 23<sup>rd</sup>.
