I. <u>EXECUTIVE SUMMARY</u>

Girls Rugby Colorado (GRC), a 501(c)(3) non profit organization, requests a fee waiver in the amount of \$200 for the use of Pinery Park grass field for their practices on October 2, 9, 16, and 23, 2024. This is for 10 players and 2 coaches.

II. BACKGROUND

Girls Rugby Colorado is a 501 C3 non-profit, values based, youth sports organization helping girls to feel empowered through flag rugby. As a non-profit organization they strive to keep their program affordable and offer scholarships to any families in need.

III. <u>REQUEST</u>
