DESCRIPTION: Fourth Amendment of Contract and Purchase Order to National Fire & Safety for 2026 Preventative Fire Equipment Inspection Services for Douglas County Facilities per IFB #044-22.

SUMMARY: Douglas County Facilities, Fleet & Emergency Support Services (FFESS) received funding approval in the 2026 Adopted Budget to continue the preventative fire equipment inspection services.

In December 2022, an Invitation for Bid process was completed, and IFB #044-22 was awarded to National Fire & Safety as the successful bidder.

The total price of the annual contract with National Fire & Safety for fire equipment inspection services is Thirty-One Thousand Nine Hundred Ninety-Eight Dollars and Zero Cents (\$31,998.00) for 2026.

With the addition of this Amendment to the Contract, the total allocation for services is One Hundred Twenty-Four Thousand Six Hundred Two Dollars and No Cents (\$124,602.00) for services outlined in the contract.

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Approval of Fourth Amendment of Contract and Purchase Order to National Fire & Safety for Thirty-One Thousand Nine Hundred Ninety-Eight Dollars and Zero Cents (\$31,998.00) for the 2026 preventative fire equipment inspection services in response to IFB #044-22.
