




# Officer K-9 Memorial Project

# Objective




The goal of my Eagle Project is to build a K-9 Memorial, to honor all the K9s who have served.



# Phase 1 Materials

80 lbs concrete, approx. 8 bags- \$5.74 a bag -\$45.92

20 cinder blocks- \$2.70 a block -\$54

1 70 lb bag masonry cement- \$16.97

El Dorado Stone- ~\$500


Slab of granite- ~\$300

Bronze plaque ( including already used brass plates)- \$ 2,951.31

29 extra plates for remaining slots- \$1740

Total: ~\$5608.2








# Finished Product

Our plaque will be mounted on a granite top, instead of concrete.



# Who is building it?

# Phase 1 Timeline



## Buy Materials

Buy materials needed for building



## Set Cement

Set cement, and let it set for 1 week.



## Build The Pillar

Build the Pillar itself.



## Place Plaque

Put the Plaque down and finish the building piece of the project.



## Phase Two

- Phase Two is a bronze statue of a german shepard.
- The statue costs \$8,800, and is only an option if I can fundraise enough money to purchase it.






\*Statue is lifesize.




# Phase Two Materials

# Fundraising

- My family will front the money for phase 1 to ensure it is completed.
- In order to raise enough money for the project, I will need to talk to veterinary clinics, reach out to friends and family, and canvas door to door.
- If I can't raise enough to complete phase two, all proceeds not used on phase one will be donated to the Douglas County Sheriff's Office.
- The total cost of both phases is ~ \$14,400, so I plan to raise \$15,000, to be used for any maintenance to the memorial.
