DESCRIPTION: Resolution for Temporary Road Closures Associated with the Pine Drive and Pine Lane Improvements Project, Douglas County Project Numbers CI 2020-019 and CI 2020-020.

SUMMARY: Douglas County Public Works Engineering and the Contractor selected for the Pine Drive and Pine Lane Improvements Project has identified four temporary road closures that are necessary for construction of the project. These closures will take place during the projects contractual time period, between July 15, 2026 and July 29, 2027.

The first, second, and third closures are needed for installation of a new 96-inch culvert that passes under the intersection of Pine Lane and Ponderosa Drive, as well as associated roadway improvements. The large culvert extends through the entire intersection at an angle and these closures allow for the culvert to be installed in segments safely. This first closure will be on the south side of the Pine Drive and Ponderosa Drive intersection and extend approximately 1000 feet to the south on Pine Lane. The closure will be for a maximum of 18 days, up to 6 days at a time, between Monday and Saturday. The second closure will be on Ponderosa Drive on the west side of the intersection of Ponderosa Drive and Pine Drive, and will extend 1000 feet to the west. This closure will be for a maximum of 85 days. The third closure will be on Ponderosa Drive on the east side of the intersection of Ponderosa Drive and Pine Drive, and will extend 500 feet to the east. The closure will be for a maximum of 25 days, up to 2 days at a time, on Saturday and Sunday. Access to all residents, churches, and businesses will remain open throughout the duration of this road closure.

The fourth closure is needed for installation for required storm infrastructure improvements, new roadway construction and ancillary roadway improvements on Pine Lane. This closure starts at the western side of the Pine Lane and Pine Drive intersection and extends west on Pine Lane to Crown Crest Boulevard. This closure will be for a maximum of 85 days.

All temporary road closures provide a safer condition for the construction crews and the traveling public. These road closures were identified as necessary during project design and discussed at a staff level and with the County’s engineering consultant who prepared the final construction plans. Pine Lane and Ponderosa Drive will not be closed at the same time. Public information efforts for notification of this work and closures have already begun with nearby residents, churches and businesses. Detailed detour instructions will be communicated through the proper channels to the residents, churches, businesses and traveling public ahead of the closures.

The method for handling traffic (MHT) will be reviewed and approved by Douglas County Engineering staff prior to implementation of these road closures.
