DESCRIPTION: Highlands Ranch Law Enforcement Training Facility Invoice for 2026 Facility Use in the Amount of \$165,960.00.

SUMMARY: Per Colorado POST Rule 28 - In-Service Training Program, In-Service training is mandatory for certified peace officers who are currently employed in positions requiring certified peace officers as defined in Colorado Revised Statutes section 16-2.5-102. This includes certified full-time, part-time and reserve peace officers. Such training is required each calendar year and includes arrest control, driving, and firearm skills. The HRELTF, located in Douglas County, has served as the primary training location for the DCSO for over 30 years and meets the needs of the DCSO very well. Training conducted at the HRLETF includes basic and advanced firearms and mandatory proficiency testing, basic and advanced officer-safety tactics, arrest control, CPR, first aid, less lethal weapons, physical fitness, and other required classroom trainings.

Adequate funding has been appropriated to accommodate the payment of this invoice which will be allocated appropriately by business unit utilizing the General Fund (\$74,880 for 208 FTEs), the LEA Fund (\$75,600 for 192 FTEs and 18 Reserves), and the School Safety Fund (\$15,480 for 43 FTEs).

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Request the Board approve the 2026 Facility Use invoice in the amount of \$165,960.00.
