**DESCRIPTION:** Seventh Amendment to the Allied Universal Security Services Public Contract for Services for 2026 Justice Center and County Building Security in the Amount of \$1,222,726.00

**SUMMARY:** On January 11, 2022, the Board of County Commissioners awarded RFP #045-21 to Allied Universal Security Services. Four one-year options to extend the related agreement were included for the following:

- 1) Robert A. Christensen Justice Center
- 2) Highlands Ranch Substation (HRSS)
- 3) Wilcox Building, Miller Building, and the parking structure
- 4) Park Meadows Motor Vehicle Office
- 5) Highlands Ranch Motor Vehicle Office
- 6) Human Services Building
- 7) Lansing Point

This Seventh Amendment utilizes the final one-year renewal option and extends the agreement for the period of January 1, 2026 through December 31, 2026, provides pay increases for the contracted staff to retain and recruit employees in the current market, and increases the Maximum Contract Liability from \$1,206,532 to \$1,222,726.

Adequate funding is anticipated to be appropriated in the 2026 adopted budget for the Sheriff's Office and Facilities Management, and separate purchase orders will be processed accordingly upon approval of the Seventh Amendment.
