FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE PUBLIC CONTRACT FOR SERVICES BETWEEN BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF DOUGLAS COUNTY ON BEHALF OF THE DOUGLAS COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE AND DOUGLAS COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT RE-1 THE SHARING OF COSTS FOR PROVIDING DEPUTY SHERIFFS TO ACT AS SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICERS

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT to the AGREEMENT made and entered into this _____ day of _____ 2024, by and between the BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF DOUGLAS COUNTY, State of Colorado (the "County"), on behalf of the DOUGLAS COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE (the "Sheriff") and DOUGLAS COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT RE-1 (the "School District").

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the County and the School District entered into an Intergovernmental Agreement, dated September 12, 2023, for the period of July 1, 2023 – June 30, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the County and the School District now desire to amend the Agreement to 1) provide seven (7) additional Deputy Sheriffs to the School District to act as SROs for the remaining four months of the 2023/2024 school year (March 1, 2024 through June 30, 2024) and 2) adjust the shared training costs outlined in the original 2023/2024 IGA as reflected in ATTACHMENT A-1. ATTACHMENT A-1 is attached and incorporated hereto; and

WHEREAS, the County and the District now desire to update and replace ATTACHMENT C. ATTACHMENT C is attached and incorporated hereto; and

WHEREAS, the Parties desire that any Agreement term not specifically amended herein continue in full force and effect; and

WHEREAS, the County has budgeted and appropriated the necessary funds to satisfy the financial obligations set forth in the Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and promises contained herein, the County and the School District agree to modify the below sections as follows:

- 1. <u>Section 1, STAFFING</u>: The County, through the Douglas County Sheriff, shall provide: two (2) SRO Sergeants; two (2) SRO Corporals; and *twenty-six* (26) Deputy Sheriffs to function as SROs for the School District *starting March 1, 2024*.
- 2. <u>Section 2h, SRO DUTIES</u>: Elementary SRO's will be assigned to a zone. A zone will contain approximately *three (3)* elementary schools. SROs will contact assigned schools on a daily basis, either by physical presence or through available forms of electronic communication.

3. <u>Section 7, FINANCIAL COST SHARING:</u>

The following paragraph is hereby added to **Section 7**, **FINANCIAL COST SHARING**:

The County and the School District agree to share the additional ongoing and start-up costs associated with the seven (7) new SROs as outlined in ATTACHMENT A-1. The School District shall pay its share of the one-time capital contribution within 30 days execution of this amendment and its portion of the costs outlined on a quarterly basis upon receipt of an invoice provided by the County, net 30 days.

4. <u>ATTACHMENT C</u>: All tables in ATTACHMENT C have been replaced with the tables attached hereto and incorporated herein.

All remaining terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
